The Impact of War on Religious Freedom in Ukraine

Tuesday, January 31, 5:00-6:00 PM at the Washington Hilton Holmesmead Room (Lobby Level)

A panel of senior Ukrainian religious leaders and legal experts will discuss the devastating impact of Russia's war on Ukraine on religious organizations and religious freedom in Ukraine. They will address the critical role the Russian Orthodox Church (Moscow Patriarchate) has played in supporting the war and the challenges this presents to the Ukrainian government, which must stop harmful actions of the ROC-MP without violating its own laws regulating religious affairs. They will describe the 26 year work of the All Ukrainian Council of Churches and Religious Organizations and its important role in strengthening democracy and religious freedom in Ukraine and in supporting the nation during wartime.
